



Re: Fireworks Display at Enfield Town Park on Saturday 4th November 2023

I would like to provide you with further information regarding the proposed Fireworks Display at Enfield Town Park on **Saturday 4th November 2023**.

We are working to deliver this exciting event and hope that this event brings the community together to enjoy the forthcoming display.

The event will take place **on Saturday 4th November 2023** between 5pm and 9pm. The display will be a fully choreographed firework extravaganza lasting approximately 15 minutes scheduled for around 7.30pm. The event will include lots of family activities including performances as well as catering outlets.

Tickets can be purchased in advance of the event online via [Enfield Town Park Fireworks | Dugdale Arts Centre](#) or at the box office at the Dugdale centre and culture palace in Enfield Town on the evening of the event before 7pm. The event will have a capacity limit of 5,000 people.

The construction and event schedules have been confirmed as follows:

During the event set up deliveries will predominantly use the Essex road entrance into the Park. There will be security and traffic management in place at Essex road to minimise any issues during the set up and throughout the event and also in the park overnight to oversee safety of equipment on site. On the morning of Friday 3rd November 2023 there will be a small number of vehicles using Essex Road entrance, with most vendors arriving from midday on Saturday 4th November 2023. The park will be closed to the public as of midday on Saturday 4th November 2023. A small number of vehicles will access the site from 6.30am Monday 6th November 2023 to collect event infrastructure i.e. fencing etc

Attendees will be permitted to access the park at either the Cecil road gate or the gate adjacent to Enfield Town Community Church attendees will not be permitted access via Essex Road.

New River Loop, Old Park Ridings and Carrs Lane footpaths will be restricted access from 7pm to 8pm

for public safety during the fireworks display. Notices will be suitably placed in advance of the event.

There will also be traffic management officers deployed in Raleigh Road, Sydney Road, Uvedale Road, Walsingham Road and Park Crescent restricting access to residents only between 4pm and 21:15pm

What roads will be affected and when?

Pre event:

No Waiting Cones to be deployed at the Junction of Essex Road/London Road
Reversal of one way system – Essex Road on Friday 3rd November 2023 and Monday 6^h November 2023

During the event:

Resident Access only into the following Roads

Uvedale Road
Walsingham Road
Park Crescent
Rayleigh Road
Sydney Road
Essex Road

What measures are being taken to stop people parking in the residential areas surrounding the park?

A traffic management company has been engaged to manage traffic surrounding the park. They will be stationed in all of the roads mentioned above in order to ensure that access is restricted to residents only. They will be present 16:00pm to 21.15pm on Saturday 4th November 2023. The Council's Parking Enforcement Team have been notified of the event and will be present in the area.

Who do I contact if a vehicle is blocking my access to my home/business?

Please contact the Council on 0208 132 2184, alternatively, you can talk to one of the road marshals stationed throughout the event and surrounding area.

What if road closures affect access to my property?

Residents will still be permitted access into the side roads. Road marshals will ensure free access to residents and residents are recommended to carry a copy of the letter sent.

Will the event affect public transport?

Although tube and bus services will be busier than usual, TfL envisions a normal service throughout the weekend.

Is there a cleansing operation in place for areas outside of the park?

There is a cleansing operation for areas both inside and outside of the park. Enfield Council's Staff will provide extra cleansing of the surrounding areas during and immediately after the event.

Will I be able to use the rest of the park and if so, will it be safe?

The Park will be closed from midday on Saturday 4th November 2023 and will reopen as per normally park opening times on Sunday 5th November 2023. There will still be some of the event infrastructure leaving the site on Monday 6th November 2023 and recommend members of public to be cautious of any moving vehicles

What is being done to address anti-social behaviour?

Entry and exit from the event will be tightly controlled by an independent security company. Access to the event is via Cecil Road entrance and the gate besides Enfield Community Church and way finders will redirect people to use the correct entrance.

The event will **not** include the sale of alcohol and attendees are not allowed to bring any liquids into the event.

All security staff are SIA-accredited (the industry standard) and well-trained in dealing with crime and disorder issues. Any member of the public causing a nuisance will be required to leave the site and a note of this made in our records.

In addition, the Police are aware of this event and will intermittently be in attendance.
